DESCRIPTION

Due to the sloppy & awkward work area, Injured Person (IP) mis-judged the condition and wounded her left leg below the knee (laceration) with a bush knife she was using during grass cutting.

LESSONS

- All short term casuals engaged must attend GSI training.
- Business Partner Supervisors and Safety Observers must attend JSA training and be familiar with compiling and understanding a JSA.
- Contractor checklist must be done onsite prior to executing the task.
- Standard PPE for grass cutting must be provided

ACTIONS

- Grass cutters must be issued PPE before re-engagement of work – Business Partner responsibility.
- Stand down until GSI training is provided – Business Partner responsibility
- Grass trimmers to be used – Business Partner responsibility
- Third party/ Casual Management must be captured in Safety Management Plan
