- Main Outcome of Activity
- > Demerits issued to OTML/Business partners
- 22 Demerits issued, 1x driving without valid OTML permit, 21 x failure to comply with applicable standard / road rules (untagged fire extinguishers)
- Police issued 8 Traffic Infringement Notices amounted to K2800.00 fines
- Positives of the activity
- OTML/Business partners now checking and getting their fire extinguishers for checking and tagging at Fire Maintenance workshop
- The activity reminded the workforce of the importance of safety in LV & Mobile equipment safety, especially with proper vehicle checks during pre-starts and not just ticking off the boxes
- > Improvements of the Activity
- Manpower increase when executing the tasking in the next NMSW so that road blocks can be executed safely, effectively and efficiently
- Take 5 & debrief to be conducted with all team members before and after tasking at the location
