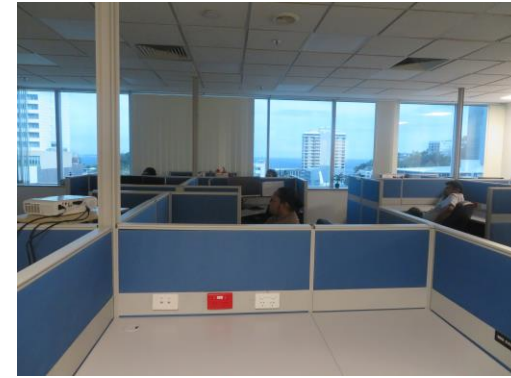
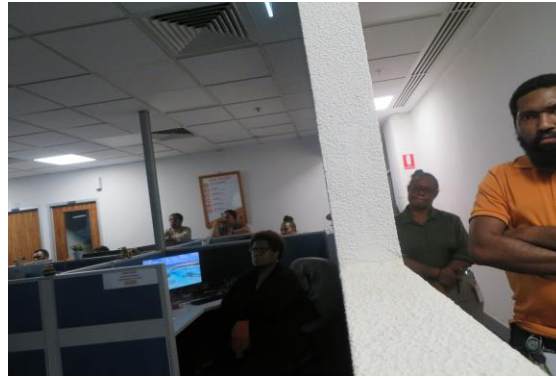
Anthony Oala covered on the Mining Industry FFR as well as the Major Hazards and MES in focus.

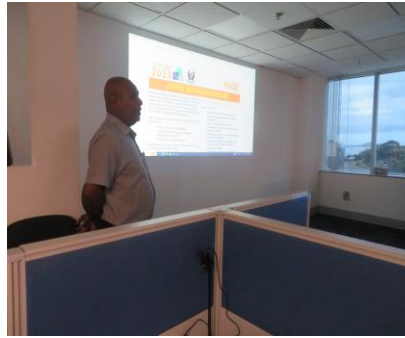
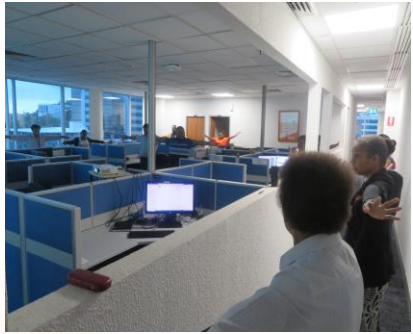
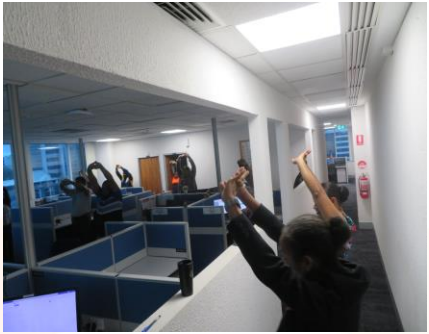
Participants were attentive to the video presentation of OTML Looking Beyond the Horizon.

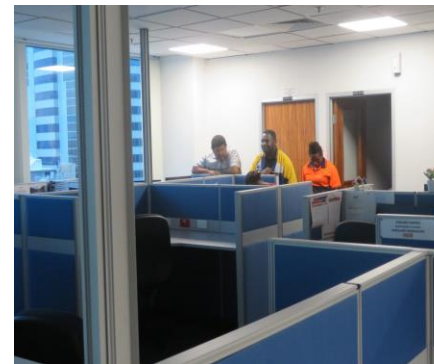
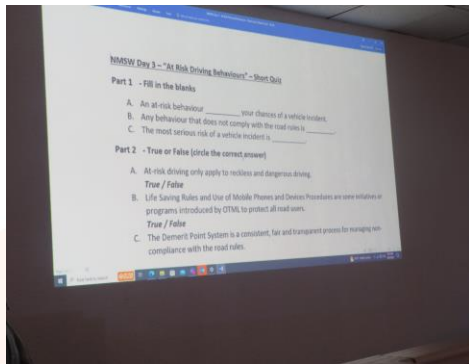

Quiz activity by Jenny Bosep. Divided staff into 5 groups. The activity was very interactive and gives more insight into the topic.

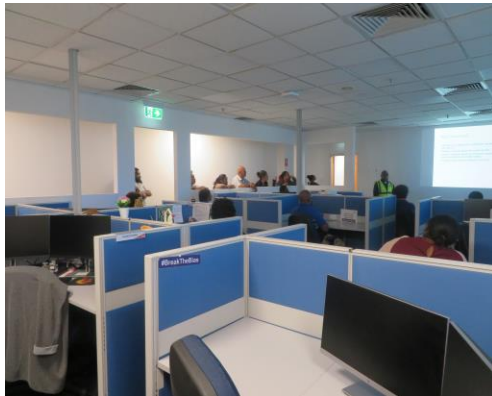
